

Angelic Tails Service Agreement

Socialization

Dogs that have not been regularly socialized with other dogs, may not understand appropriate dog signals or be able to engage in healthy and safe play. That is why we are here and why we consider our Day Camp to be a much safer alternative to dog parks. We monitor and evaluate each dog's ability to participate in group play, and will determine what level of comfort each dog has to be a positive influence in their group. A fun and safe environment for doggie play is our objective.

Owner acknowledges that dogs play differently from humans - they use their teeth, and paws and nails, and even their bodies to engage in playing and communicating with other dogs. Their play may result in bites, scratches, or sore muscles, paws, or joints. As these issues are a natural aspect of doggie play, owner agrees to hold Angelic Tails without liability should any of these circumstances occur.

Health

Owner understands that by admitting their dog to Angelic Tails, they have confirmed that their dog is free of any communicable diseases including fleas or ticks, and has not been on antibiotics for any reason, for the past 21 days. Any existing illness, or any diagnosis requiring ongoing medications must be disclosed prior to coming to Camp.

Owner understands that dogs breathe and sneeze and bark all over each other in the course of play, and any bacterial or viral diseases brought into Day Camp are not the responsibility of Angelic Tails. Angelic Tails will not be responsible for loss, damages, or expenses incurred as a result of time spent at Angelic Tails.

Bordatella or Canine Influenza vaccine updates - dogs must remain at home for 21 days following inoculation. No exceptions.

After Camp

Dogs playing with other dogs is a different kind of exercise than dogs going on runs or walks with their humans. They are much more tired and may be slightly sore or fatigued after camp. Slight strains or muscles pulls are not uncommon and will likely heal with time and rest. Feel free to ask your vet ahead of time to confirm this, so you will be comfortable if it should ever happen.

Water is available at all times for everyone, but some dogs will not drink enough to compensate for the amount of exercise they are getting. When they get home, water should be given in increments - don't let them drink a whole bowl at one time.
